



Fr. Kevin's Cluttered Desk

Penance and sacrifice that leads us to transformation and fullness of life.

So, what might that look like in our daily lives?

- 1. **Give up sin:** If it's wrong, don't do it! Self-discipline in the small things makes us strong for when we face bigger challenges.
- 2. **Pray:** Prayer is a conversation that requires both speaking and listening. If you tend to talk more than you listen, try Eucharistic Adoration.
- 3. **Fasting:** Intermittent fasting is all the rage; think of all the weight you can lose. But instead of fasting to lose weight consider that fasting is an ancient tradition meant to strengthen the mind, the body, and one's relationship with God.
- 4. **Do good works:** Do the little things before being asked.
- 5. **Give alms:** Sign up for Pre-Authorized Giving; even when you're not there the lights and heat still need to be paid for.
- 6. **Abstain:** If a vegan can live completely without meat, you and I can go one day a week without meat. Our suffering is nothing compared to how much Jesus suffered for us.
- 7. **Carry out our duties of life:** Love of God, love of neighbour means building relationships, good holy relationships.
- 8. **Spiritual reading:** Try reading scripture or the life of the Saints or just one Saint.
- 9. **Control our desire for possessions:** Hide your credit cards and buy nothing but basic needs for 40 days.
- 10.**Control desire for entertainment:** Suspend, limit, or schedule your streaming; even an hour a day can be too much

Everything begins with small steps, but until you take the first step, you have gone no where and nothing can change, nothing can happen.
