
Sign up sheets are located in the main church entrance of both churches. We need at least two people signed up every hour.

**Many people are asking why we are having Communion under one Species during July and August.** No, it is not because it is summer time or because we just needed a break. The reality is that we no longer have enough Eucharistic Ministers to make Communion under both Species possible at any of our Masses! Each Mass at Assumption requires 7 Eucharistic Ministers and each Mass at St. Basil's requires 5 Eucharistic Ministers. That means that we need 28 volunteers per month at each Mass at Assumption and 20 per month at each Mass at St. Basil's to make a one month rotation. Right now there aren't enough volunteers to cover 1 week! And no, the situation is not going to improve at the end of August. **WE NEED VOLUNTEERS!!**



To become a Eucharistic Minister is not difficult – pray about the decision, read and sign the Model Code of Conduct and the Volunteer Information Form available in the office, do some one-on-one training to learn how to serve, and be able to attend short trainings with Fr. Kevin when required. We ask that you pray about serving as a Eucharistic Minister and talk to either Laura or Roisin in the office if you would like more information. Please don't wait for someone else to volunteer – **we need volunteers now, not later!**

## Fr. Kevin's Cluttered Desk

Is it really a Caesar Salad if it contains bacon bits? Did you know a Caesar salad (also spelled Cesar and Cesare) is a green salad of romaine lettuce and croutons dressed with lemon juice (or lime juice), olive oil, egg, Worcestershire sauce, anchovies, garlic, Dijon mustard, Parmesan cheese, and black pepper? But as a friend of mine put it, "If it is a Caesar Salad it must be Roman and the Romans would always put pork in it." Sadly a Caesar Salad is not Roman and is not even Italian. So what has this to do with faith? Well, the question is do we know why we do what we do? What is the reason, what is the history?

- When you enter the church why bless yourself with Holy Water? To renew our baptismal promises and remember we are all God's children.
- Why genuflect before you sit down? A sign of respect and honor: for at the name of Jesus every knee should bend and every voice proclaim that Jesus is Lord.
- Why say a prayer of thanks after receiving the Eucharist? Do you not say thank you after receiving something, especially a gift?
- Why bow your head when the priest genuflects after the elevation and say to yourself, "My Lord and my God"? A miracle has just taken place, God is truly present.
- Why get your children baptized as infants and not let them choose? Baptism is a gift not a choice.
- Why go to church every week? Are you just taking out fire insurance or is eating with Jesus important to you? We are invited to a meal, why would we say no and reject Jesus?
- Do you come to the mass with your intentions? We are sent forth from the last mass to discover the needs of the people and to bring them back to God at our next visit.
- Do you read the readings over before you come to church? Are you prepared in case you cannot understand the one proclaiming the readings, have you reflected on the readings?
- In the Communion procession are you focused on Jesus or on the people around you? As we process we are to not only focus ourselves on Jesus but help those around us to focus and not be a distraction for them or others.
- Do we know and understand why God loves us? God loved us first for He created us and knit us each together.

Why do we do what we do?

I have been known to put minced garlic and finely chopped Spanish onions in my Cesar salad because I like onion and garlic. Why do we do what we do, in our lives, in our faith, in our sinfulness and in our holiness?
