




Sunday Reflection






Fr. Kevin's Cluttered Desk

I remember once saying to my dad, "why did you not tell me that when I was younger?" and my dad responded, "would you have listened?" There is something to be said for maturity. Sadly, I am not sure everyone knows what that means. Being mature is not about age, it is a mental thing. It has a lot to do with our development of our conscience, our ethic, our moral values and how we live them. Maturity is about taking responsibility for our actions and not blaming things of our lives on other people. Being mature is about claiming ownership our choices and not blaming others for what we do or say. Until we hit a level of maturity we are unable or unwilling to hear or listen to many things. Or we are not willing or open to bearing and living the truth. I will give you an interesting example, or one I think is interesting: from God's point having a child is a privilege but in our world today often times being pregnant is not seen as a privilege but rather an inconvenience or ruination of one's life. As my dad said long ago, "would I have listened", probably not, mainly because I was not mature enough to listen or want to listen to someone else's wisdom, I was not ready to hear the truth/bear the truth.
