Just as the altar is a sign for us of Christ the living stone, altar cloths are used "out of reverence for the celebration of the memorial of the Lord and the banquet that gives us his "body" and by their beauty and form, they add to the dignity of the altar in much the same way that vestments solemnly ornament the priests. This ministry allows us to put our faith and prayers in action to help support the Liturgy at All Saints Parish. All linens and towels used at Mass and all other Liturgical celebrations are washed and ironed each week. Training is provided for the special care the linens need before they can be washed, removing stains and directions for folding/ironing.
