

PAC meeting June 20, 2018

1. Opening prayer led by Richard Shelson (Aaron absent this evening).
2. Acceptance of Agenda. Motion made by Peter Lilienthal, seconded by Cyndi Lilienthal. CARRIED.
3. Review and Acceptance of May 2018 minutes. Item 6b should also include Helen Manzara in the list of coordinators. Motion to accept amended minutes made by Peter Lilienthal, seconded Don Bruchet. CARRIED.
4. Pastor's Report
 - a) From the Finance Council Meeting: Our finances are looking good! While we are off \$1000 from last year, our total receipts are ahead of last year by \$13,000. Our total expenditures are also ahead of last year by \$10,000. There will be \$65,000 added to the Building Fund by the end of June from the 10 Cities Gala, the Lobster Dinner, the CWL Plant Sale, etc.
 - b) The land we have purchased for the new church has now been cleared and No Trespassing signs have been put up. There have been some issues with trespassing and theft. The cost of the clean-up was \$60,000 plus \$3000 for GST. The land has been rented out for hay and proceeds will go to the Diocese.
 - c) The new Mass schedule will go into the bulletin this coming weekend and onto the monthly schedule for August and September. This gives everyone an opportunity to see it and become more familiar.
 - d) The bus for Derek Remus's Ordination will leave at 3:30 p.m. The cost is \$35 per person and there is room for 10 more people. Our group will have reserved seating at the Cathedral.
 - e) Many thanks to Ann Morgan and her Committee for a wonderful Corpus Christi procession! People found it to be a moving and faith-filled experience!
 - f) Marie and Steve Burger are moving to the Crowsnest Pass and so we are again looking for representatives for the Ecumenical Council. Maureen Condon-Horon will cover this position temporarily until someone is found. Our Parish needs to

maintain this important relationship with the other churches. Fr. Kevin has also been approached to join the Evangelical Council.

g) Our Parish is in need of NEW music ministers, especially for the new Saturday night Mass! So far there have only been some inquiries.

h) There were 45 people who signed up to sponsor children through Chalice at the sessions last weekend! Alice Matisz will find out how many children/elderly persons are being sponsored by our parish members. Please consider this important ministry!

i) Fr. Lukas's sister gave birth to a stillborn child Sunday and passed away herself on Monday. If you are able to go and support the family, prayers for her will be held at St. Albert the Great Parish on Friday, June 22 at 7:30 p.m. and the funeral Mass will be on Saturday, June 23 at St. Bonaventure Parish at 12 noon. Both churches are in Calgary. Please keep Fr. Lukas and his family in your prayers.

5. New Business

a) A question was raised regarding the proceeds returned from the 10 City Gala, which was about \$23,000 and the Lobster Supper, which was about \$4,000.

b) A request was made that we place a sign at the land for the new church to identify it as the future home of All Saints. Fr. Kevin wants to wait to do this until there is approval of the design from the Bishop. He would like to include the design on the sign.

c) A concern was raised about working to end the divisions in the Parish and bringing about healing. We need to stop seeing each other as enemies just because we disagree. It was noted that various groups are trying to build community through events but many people are unable or don't attend. Fr. Kevin told the meeting that the CWL Councils and the K of C 1490 and 1570 Councils are collaborating more and more, including the recent joint installation meeting of the K of C. Although our journey together is not an easy one, we are continuing to work on healing and growth in our community. We need to stop thinking us and them and start acting as one family, keep our focus on Christ and celebrate all the wonderful things that are happening in our Parish! The discussion resulted in a **Motion** being made: **The September 19, 2018 Pastoral Advisory Council meeting will be set aside to focus on unification and oneness in All Saints Parish. Motion made by Anna Travaglia-Kellogg, seconded by Lois Cicman.**
