- 1. Opening Prayer** – Led by Aaron Skretting, Chairperson
- 2. Acceptance of Agenda** – Strike #7 – No PAC Activity; Accepted with changes Mike Roberts/Lois Cicman - Moved

- 4. Pastor's Report** – Fr. Kevin
 - a. Watering of Plants – PLEASE STOP! It has been requested that those who are continuously watering plants please stop as they are already being taken care of and overwatering causes mold issues and dead plants. Please leave the flowers alone!
 - b. Hike for Life – On June 1st, 2019 at Henderson Park with a 9:00 AM registration. It would be wonderful to have a super Catholic turn out. CWL are asked to walk and wear their sashes. Father Kevin also challenges the K of C Councils to be present. You can be pledged/sponsored for fundraising or just walk and let yourself be seen as visibly standing up for life.
 - c. Finances – an updated budget will be in the bulletin this week. As of the end of April we were at a \$7000 deficit as Easter collections were off this year. On Holy Thursday the collection was split between Development and Peace and the Foodbank. The month of May is refund time for income tax so please remember All Saints.
 - d. Funerals - The priests have been very busy with funerals.
- 5. Old Business** – Father Kevin
 - a. Church and Hall Security – Doors are still being left UNLOCKED, thus leaving the Churches and Halls vulnerable to possible theft and vandalism. Changes need to be made to what we are doing. The problem is that there are too many keys out in the community. Some doors are being locked but not closed, and some others are being closed by not locked. A new security system was looked into and the prognosis would be an expenditure of over \$3000 per church, this would not include the Rectory. Much discussion ensued and it was decided that Father Kevin would look into the possibility of placing panic-bars, toggles or dead bolts on certain exterior doors, re-key a few exterior doors (with sign-out and deposit being required), and replace doors that don't close properly (even if the doorways need to

be reframed) – thus having only one main door into the church. **It would truly be best if all people with keys would be more responsible and diligent and verify who is locking and checking the doors.** There will be some growing pains while we adjust to these changes; however, these changes are necessary. Locksmiths will be contacted in the near future for more information and quotes.
