1. Background.

"Education is to help individuals capable of intellectual and moral autonomy who respect the autonomy of others, precisely by virtue of the rule of reciprocity" Piaget. So education is a process that only makes sense if it leads to positive changes in behavior. Therefore, learning in part is knowing how to adapt to these situations; Chalice scholarship students seek the opportunity to obtain a professional career in order to acquire greater skills and competencies when entering the labor force.

As a result of this program "Hope for my Future", many young people have managed to find a stable source of employment, started their businesses and others obtained scholarships to continue studying abroad so they can have a better future for themselves and their families.

2. Academic Follow-up

Academic follow-up is a necessary activity that allows us to evaluate the student's performance throughout the learning process, as well as the fulfillment of curricular activities such as: research work, participation, attendance, punctuality. In this way, students benefiting from the Chalice Scholarship Program, students who are beneficiaries of the Scholarship Program sponsored by Banco Mercantil in strategic alliance with the Universidad Católica Boliviana, formed a network of allies with institutions with the objective of supporting and strengthening the program and benefiting students with limited resources.

2.1 Sixth Generation

2.2 The sixth generation began their university career in the 1/2017 semester with nine scholarship students and concluded their studies in the 11/2019 semester. Seven of them graduated in December 2019; while two students for different reasons remained for further study as follows:

- Jhonatan Mamani Mamani, born in the city of La Paz, comes from a large family, of limited economic resources. He was a beneficiary of the scholarship program from the Guadalupe Site since the 2017.

The year 2019 he failed the subjects Taxation and Degree Workshop, however, the council of the Entrepreneurship Career, gave an opportunity for re-write of a second round exam in the subject of Taxation on January 15 of the last year. As well he made the defense of his Degree Project in February and in both he managed to pass satisfactorily. This enabled Jhonatan to graduate and that will occur the month of March this year.

- Estefani Mamani Calcina, is a beneficiary of the scholarship program from the Guadalupe Site since 2017. In 2019 the management team after exhaustive efforts to assist her made the decision to cancel her from the scholarship portion in relation to the support of CHALICE. This was as a result of her

constant absences from classes and for failing subjects. She did continue her studies with the scholarship of the Mercantile Bank.

This student did pass the subjects of Christology and Entrepreneurship on June 7, 2020. The first defense of her degree project she passed satisfactorily in September; in her second defense, after 95% of progress she failed but she was given a second chance for defense for her project and passed satisfactorily on December 17, 2020 by Zoom.

Her project called "**fried grilled ice cream based on four cereals, barley, oats, quinoa and cañahua**" is being developed together with her partner Eva Hinojosa; her final defense is scheduled for January 2021.

2.3 Seventh Generation

The seventh generation of the Community Program "Hope For my Future ", began their university careers in the I/2018 semester and will conclude in March/2021. This generation has four scholarship students. They are: Ruth Lequipe, Nilda Terán Veizaga, Eva Rebeca Hinojosa Amarro and Yhailin Yamirka Tola Choque. They are preparing their final defense for the current month, their graduation is planned for the month of March.

Four of the scholarship holders of the 7th generation continue with their internships, as in the case of Ruth Lequipe in the company ISAS, where she sells software tools, and Yhailin Terán is doing her internship in the Ministry of Defense in the accounting area.

➤ Ruth Lequipe, became a beneficiary of the scholarship program through our Amanecer Sponsor Site in the city of Cochabamba. Her family is composed of six members. The father works as a plumber where he can find jobs. The mother was engaged in informal trade selling candy and cookies around the educational units and the Public University of the city of Cochabamba. Due the pandemic she no longer can do this work. The subjects of Christology and workshop degree passed satisfactorily. She is preparing her final defense of her project "germinal biodegradable Bambu brushes" and her graduation was scheduled for the month of January 2021.

➤ Nilda Terán Veizaga, beneficiary of the Chalice scholarship program is from the Fatima Sponsor Site in the city of Cochabamba. The family is composed of 16 members. The father works as a mason and the mother is at home dedicated to raising the family. The two older children contribute to the family economy by doing odd jobs.

She passed her courses in 2020 taking some virtually. Her final defense of her project called "Mobile Beauty Salon" took place in the month of January 2021.

➤ Eva Rebeca Hinojosa Amarro, was a beneficiary of the Chalice scholarship program from the Guadalupe site in the city of La Paz. She comes from a family of six and the father and the mother support their family selling food as street vendors selling Salchipapas, located in the area of Huayllani. She was admitted to Inos Hospital in May of 2019 with health issues. She needed some support with her studies because she was in exams at that time, and we coordinated with the teachers to inform them about Eva's case and to give her the opportunity to defend herself after she was released from the hospital. In

September of this year, she had problems with her former partner and father of her child, who has not been providing support. Because of this she was accompanied to the Children's Ombudsman to file a complaint for paternal irresponsibility. An agreement was reached for monthly family assistance and weekend visits.

Through all of these challenges Eva is currently preparing her final defense of her project called "Grilled fried ice cream based on four cereals: barley, oats, quinoa and Cañahua". Since March of last year she has been doing the pre-professional practice with a workload of 240 hours ending in December 2020, and just like her classmates, her graduation is scheduled for the month of March 2021.

- Yhailin Tola Choque, beneficiary of the Chalice scholarship program from the Guadalupe site in the city of La Paz. The family consists of four and the father works as a taxi driver and the mother is at home as homemaker.

Like her classmates of the 7th generation, she passed the subjects of Degree Workshop and Christology satisfactorily. She is a student dedicated to her studies and she is preparing for her final defense.

3. Eighth Generation

In the eighth generation started in 2019 there are three students benefited by Banco Mercantil, now supported in the pursuit of their academic studies by Fundación Levantate Mujer, the following are the students and the student.

- Luz Angela Argote Valdez was benefited with the scholarship in 2019 supported by the institution FASDE, she comes from a nuclear family of scarce resources. Last year she passed her subjects with some difficulties, since the pandemic she passed virtual classes; at home she did not have a good internet signal and a computer for her virtual classes. The Guadalupe site designated her a laptop on loan until he completes his studies.

She will take her last semester with the subjects of Christology, Degree Workshop and her internships. The student will be supported to do her internships at the Guadalupe site office.

- Carla Bustamante Sullca comes from a nuclear family of a large family, currently lives alone with her younger sisters, parents live elsewhere for family problems, was awarded the scholarship in 2019 supported by the institution FASDE academic monitoring is being done by the Foundation Levántate Mujer.

Last year she passed all her subjects satisfactorily, this year she will take her last semester with the subjects of Christology, Degree Workshop and her corresponding internships.

The student is doing her internship at the Guadalupe site office since this month.

- Cristian Alderete Poma benefited by the scholarship of Banco Mercantil in 2019 with the support of the institution Fastén, comes from a nuclear family of limited resources, his family did not have an economy to make him study, was the reason that prompted him to apply for the scholarship for the career of Entrepreneurship and have job opportunities.

This semester he will take his last semester with the subjects of Christology, Degree Workshop and his internships.

4. Ninth Generation

The ninth and final generation has two scholarship recipients who benefited last year (2020) from Banco Mercantil and supported by Fundación Levántate Mujer, as follows:

- Gabriela Alvares comes from a single-parent family composed of three members. Last year she passed her subjects satisfactorily and this year she will take her second semester with the subjects where she chose the Mention of Financial and Banking Services. He is taking the following subjects:
